- A whole day of CSA practical sessions – mock CSA cases with role-players with personalised feedback and advice from experienced assessors

The Swansea MRCGP Course was established in 1994 and since then has maintained its reputation as one of the leading preparatory courses in the UK for the MRCGP.

The course director, Dr. Bob Mortimer is an experienced educationalist and is a senior CSA Assessor. He will be assisted on the course by Dr. Richard Jones, Associate Director in the Oxford Deanery and who is also a senior CSA Assessor. Those attending for the CSA sessions will include a complimentary copy of Bob Mortimer's book *The nMRCGP Handbook*.

The Oxford courses have been commissioned by the Deanery and GP Registrars from the Deanery will have priority for places on both courses. It's recommended that you try to attend the course 6-8 weeks before you plan to sit the CSA so that you have acquired sufficient skills to gain maximum benefit from the course while still leaving enough time to apply and integrate what you learn on the course.
